- A. Welcome and introduction of moderator and panelists
- B. The panelists will discuss their roles as judges and attorneys, including how many years they have been practiced law, their career backgrounds, and how these differing backgrounds have influenced their views on the practice of criminal law.
- C. Each panelist will discuss an ethical or professional issues they themselves have seen during their time on the bench or within the practice of criminal law. The panelists will then describe how that issue could have been dealt with better or how they would the parties could have handled the matter in a more effective manner.
- D. During a question and answer session, each panelist will provide their perspectives for the best handling of criminal courts and address topics such as effective communications practices, efficiency in morning docket, and motion practice.
- E. The attorneys, if time permits, can ask the panelists questions or share an experience that affected them regarding ethical issues they experience in practicing criminal law.
