ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 6.313-7/22*

IN RE: EXPLOITATION OF

VULNERABLE ADULT INJUNCTIONS

Florida Statute sections 825.1035 and 825.1036 sets forth the procedures from filing to disposition of Injunctions for Protection Against Exploitation of a Vulnerable Adult. Internal processes are to be implemented to effectuate the court's obligations under the statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

A. <u>CASE ASSIGNMENT OF PETITION FOR INJUNCTIONS OR TEMPORARY INJUNCTIONS</u>

- 1. Upon receiving a petition for injunction or temporary injunction for protection against exploitation of a vulnerable adult, the Clerk and Comptroller shall assign the case to one of the following Probate/Guardianship Division: **IA or IZ.**
- 2. The Clerk and Comptroller will check its case maintenance system and CCIS to determine if there is a pending action under Chapter 744 or another related case.
 - a. If a Chapter 744 case is pending in the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, the Petition will be filed and assigned to the same presiding judge as the open guardianship case.
 - b. If a Chapter 744 case is pending in another circuit, the Clerk and Comptroller will open a case in the guardianship division and inform the assigned judge so that a transfer order can be issued.
 - c. If a related UFC case is pending in the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, the Clerk and Comptroller will follow in the procedures outlined in Administrative Order 5.101.

The Clerk and Comptroller shall promptly deliver the petition for injunction or petition for temporary injunction and all necessary documents and information to the judge assigned to the case, via the designated electronic email accounts of the presiding judge, judicial assistant and cad-divisional address. A petition for injunction or petition for temporary injunction filed in the West County Courthouse, will be sent to Division IA.

B. <u>SCHEDULING OF HEARING</u>

Upon the entry of a temporary injunction, or upon the filing of the petition for injunction

if temporary relief is not requested, the judge reviewing the matter will schedule the hearing on the assigned judge's next Wednesday docket at 10am. The clerk will docket the notice of hearing.

C. ASSISTANCE WITH VIOLATIONS OF INJUNCTIONS

The Clerk and Comptroller is the office designated as the central intake point for injunction violations and where the petitioner can receive assistance in the preparation of the affidavit in support of violation.

SERVICE OF INJUNCTIONS FOR PROTECTION AGAINST EXPLOITATION OF A D. VULNERABLE ADULT

- 1. Florida Statute § 825.1035(10)(a)1.c provides that the Chief Judge of each circuit, in consultation with the appropriate sheriff, may authorize a law enforcement agency within the Chief Judge's jurisdiction to effect service of the injunction and temporary injunction on the respondent and affected financial institutions. The Chief Judge has consulted with the Sheriff of Palm Beach County with regard to which law enforcement agencies within Palm Beach County have received the training necessary to effectively serve the injunctions and temporary injunctions. The following agencies are hereby authorized to serve the injunctions and temporary injunctions.
